

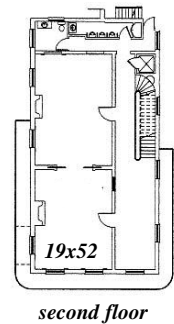
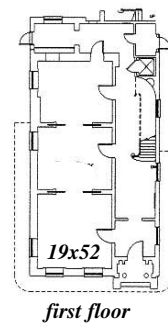

- Location:
- Located in the heart of the French Quarter at 840 Conti Street in New Orleans
 - Adjacent to the Prince Conti Hotel, the Valentino Conti House provides elegant meeting and banquet space facilities for small to large groups

- Amenities:
- Elegant meeting, banquet and reception facilities are located on the first two floors of the four-story building
 - Groups up to 200 persons
 - Perfect for small board meetings or large groups
 - 2,000 square feet of varied available space
 - Creative catering provided by The Bombay Club, Restaurant and Martini Bistro
 - Discreetly equipped with a sound system, dial tone, internet access, drop-down screens and video projectors



- History:
- Constructed in 1835 by James Gallier, Sr., a renowned designer of the period
 - American-style side hall London-planned home with Greek Revival-style features
 - Three parlors on the first floor were living and entertaining areas, the two parlors on the second floor were used for family dining
 - The original kitchen was detached and the slave quarters building was used for servants
 - Most notable resident: E.J. Bellocq, a commercial photographer famous for glass plate images of ladies of the Storyville Red Light District in the early 1900's
